



Workshop Call for Proposals IMS2023, San Diego, CA

Important dates:

Workshop proposals due 16 September 2022

Workshop dates: 11 June 2023 (Sunday), 12 June 2023 (Monday) and 16 June 2023 (Friday)

Proposals Information: Workshop organizers will have to fill out an online submission form including relevant information such as the workshop title, abstract and a list of confirmed speakers with the title and abstract of their presentations. When submitting the proposal, workshop organizers will not need to have the endorsement of MTT Technical Committees. However, since the Technical Committees will be involved in the review process, selecting at least one Technical Committee with affinity with the topics addressed in the workshop proposal will be necessary.

Proposals Submission: Workshop proposals should be uploaded through a link that will be available on the IMS2023 website. A notification of acceptance will be sent on 25 November 2022 to the submitting organizer. Slides and speaker notes in the specified format will be due by 28 April 2023.

Workshops: Half-day workshops are expected to have 4–5 speakers and full-day workshops 8–10 speakers, with a lunch break and morning/ afternoon breaks. Workshops tend to be more successful and better attended if the organizers include interactive elements.
